- Over \$180,000 worth of free technical support through our partnerships



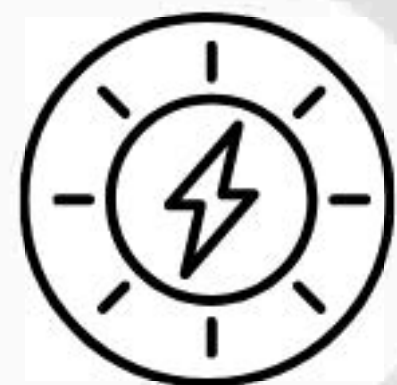
DIRECT OUTREACH
