\$36 million in grant funding including:

- **8 million** for Electric vehicle chargers
- **9 million** Solar for low-income residents
- **8 million** Weatherization and energy efficiency for low-income residents
- Approximately **8 million** investment from Bloomberg Philanthropies, including 3 innovation staff members added
- Funding awarded to help make commercial buildings more energy efficient



Accomplishments:

- Renewable Natural Gas
- Adopted a Sustainable Procurement Policy
- Adopted a Electric Fleet Procurement Plan
- Received over \$100,000 from Elective Pay and the Installation of 5 Public EV Chargers
- Over 2 million metric ton of CO2 diverted
- Over 30 electric vehicles in our fleet
