AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

SYNOPSIS: Victim was waiting at the RTA bus stop at Needmore and Frederick Pike when he realized he missed the bus. The victim continued walking to his sister's house when he could tell the unknown suspect was approaching him from behind. The suspect put his arm around the victim and said "you know what time it is?" The victim responded "No, I don't have my phone." The suspect then hit the victim in the back and stomach numerous **times** with a wooden baseball bat before fleeing the scene with three other unknown individuals.

CASE STATUS: Detective attempted to make contact with the victim, but was met with negative results.

SYNOPSIS: (This is one incident, but has three victims) Unknown suspect inside a silver Hyundai Sonata shot one round at the victim's vehicle. The victim's vehicle consisted of the driver, a front seat passenger, and the driver's daughter in the backseat. The Hyundai was located behind 1101 Huffman Avenue. Officers and Sergeant Dine spoke with the owners at those addresses and they denied knowing anything about the vehicle. The vehicle was towed along with two cellphones that were right outside the door as being abandoned and blocking the alley.

CASE STATUS: No detective supplementary report entered at this time.

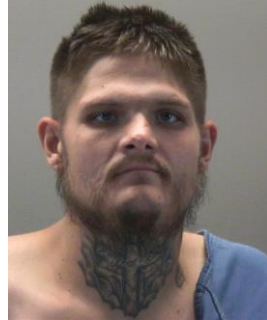

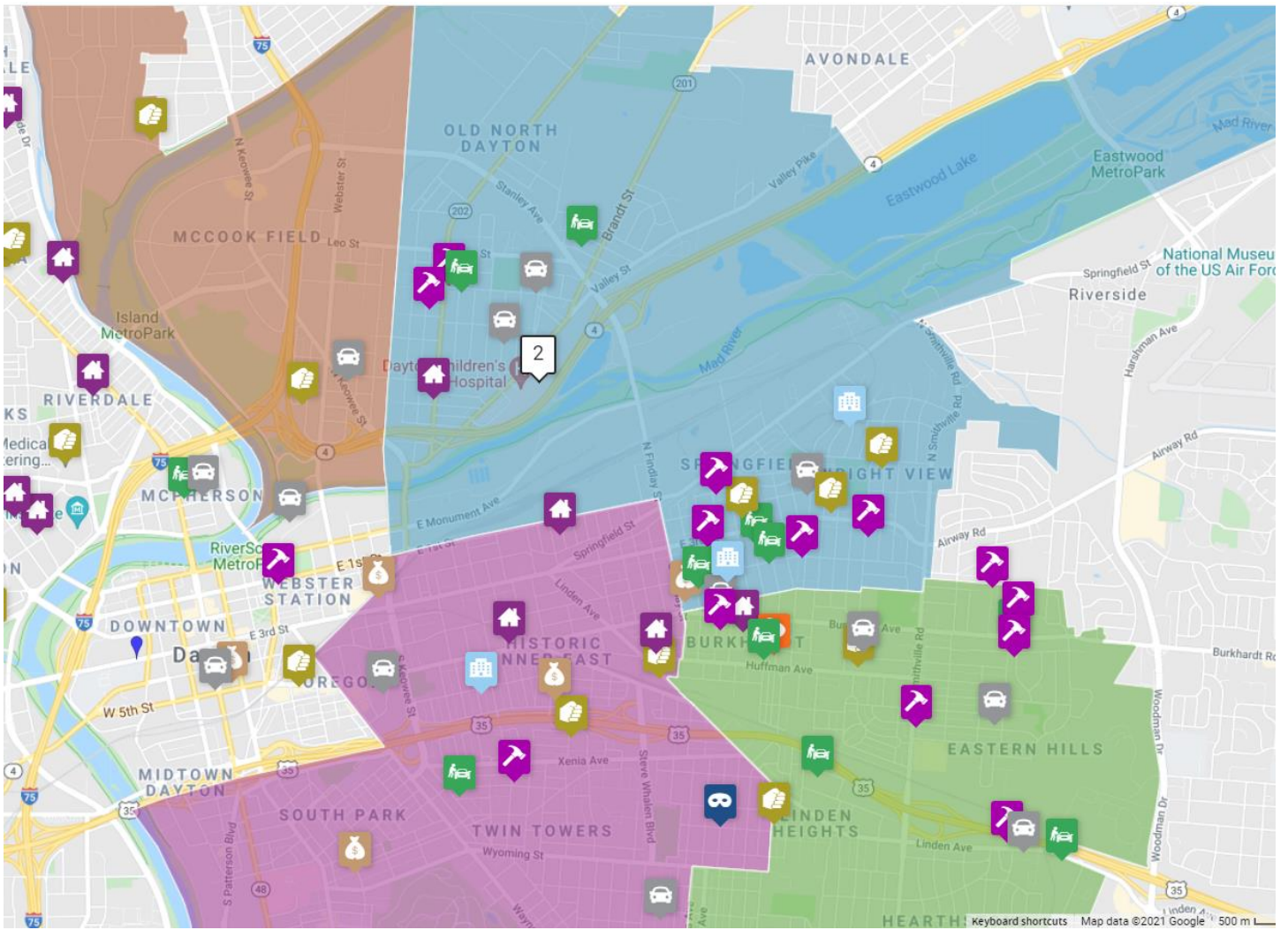
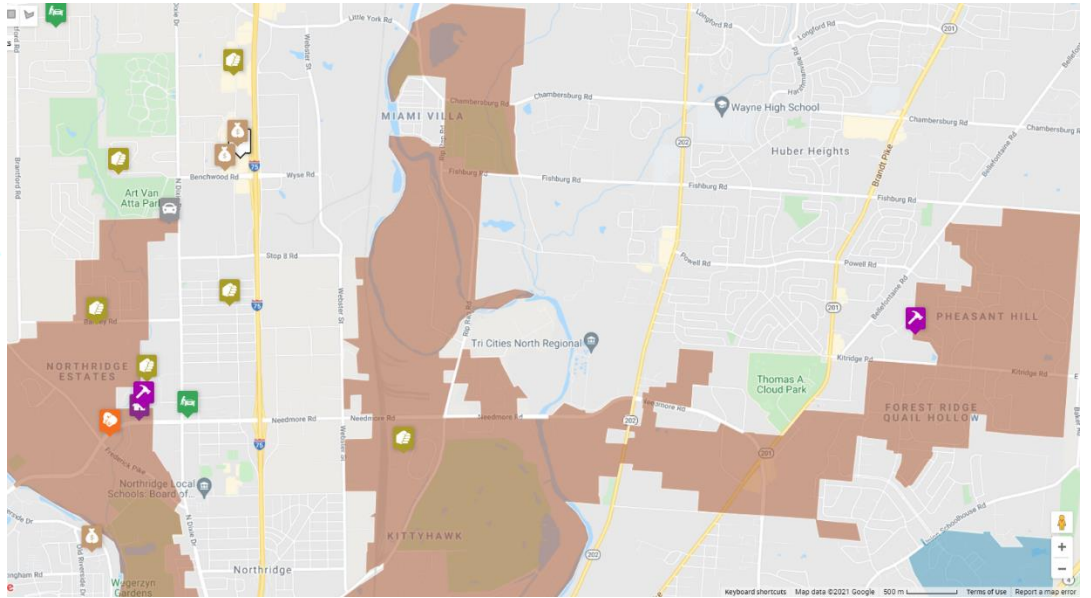

How to Prevent Trailer Thefts



- Use a hitch lock- this makes it more time consuming for thieves to steal your trailer
- Park your trailer in a well-lit area- most criminals do not want to be seen committing crimes
- You can also park your trailer in an area such as a fenced backyard or garage
- Make sure you have the license plate or registration information written down
- Mark your trailer with identifiable marks
- Block the tires with tire blocks or cinder blocks
- Lock your wheels
- Remember, if you see something, say something

DO YOU NEED A SAFE PLACE FOR YOUR BABY TO SLEEP?

Families must meet the following requirements to participate in the Safe Sleep Program:

- Have no other safe sleep space such as crib, pack 'n play or bassinet or ability to obtain one
- Families eligible for receiving government assistance such as WIC, Medicaid, etc.
- At least 32 weeks pregnant or a child under 6 months of age
- Receive safe sleep education and complete required paperwork
- One pack 'n play or cribette per child

In Ohio, three babies die each week in unsafe sleep environments. These deaths are preventable by keeping in mind a few safe sleep ABC's: Babies are safest **A**lone, on their **B**ack, in an empty **C**rib.



Public Health – Dayton & Montgomery County, in collaboration with Ohio Department of Health and Cribs for Kids is providing Infant Survival Kits to parents and caregivers in our community. The Infant Survival Kit includes a cribette, fitted sheet, and educational safe sleep material.
