



Diane Shannon named director of Procurement, Management and Budget

City Manager Shelley Dickstein has announced the appointment of Diane Shannon as director of the newly formed Department of Procurement, Management and Budget, effective March 1.

Shannon, a 22-year City employee, will oversee two divisions with a total of 16 employees.

The Division of Management and Budget develops the City of Dayton's annual general and capital budgets and conducts internal audits, performance measurement, economic forecasting, and monthly Finance Committee briefings of the City Commission. The Division of Procurement is responsible for the purchase of goods, services and equipment needed for operation of City government.

"Diane's acumen in fiscal management and economics have served the City organization and the Dayton community well," said Dickstein. "We look forward to her leadership of the new department's very important mission and duties."

Shannon joined the City staff in 1996 as a management analyst. She was promoted to senior budget and management analyst in 1997 and to City economist in 1999. In 2014, Shannon was named deputy director of the Office of Management and Budget. She earned a B.S. in Business Economics and an M.S. in Economics, both from the University of South Florida.

Shannon is replacing Barbara LaBrier, previous director of Management and Budget, who is retiring from City service after more than 30 years.

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
