



New app reminds customers of waste/recycling pick-up days

Includes "what goes where" feature for recycling guidance

Dayton waste collection customers can now get reminders about scheduled garbage and recycling pick-ups by using the new "Dayton Collects" app.

In addition to cellphone notifications and reminder emails, the app sends alerts about changes to the collection schedule resulting from holidays or extreme weather.

Dayton Collects also includes a "what goes where" feature that tells app users whether materials are recyclable in Dayton's curbside collection system. The feature also indicates how and where to safely dispose of non-recyclable materials such as batteries, motor oil and many others.

The app is available for free download at the Apple and Google Play app stores and is also embedded in the City website at daytonohio.gov/daytoncollects.



Waste collection customers can continue to find schedules for viewing or printing at daytonohio.gov/daytoncollects. Paper schedules for each collection zone have been mailed to all customers, and customers can opt out of future mailings if desired.
