The beards are back!

During "No Shave October & November," local residents will notice some Dayton Police Department officers with more facial hair than normally allowed.

Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #44 was granted permission by the City of Dayton for a second year to allow its members to grow beards during the month of October (Zero Cancer Foundation) and November (Miami Valley Hospital Foundation, Champion of Hope) in return for a \$50 donation to the chosen charity.



After an officer makes the donation, he can grow a beard (normally a violation of DPD dress code) for that month. If an officer wants to keep the beard for two months, he must donate twice. The beards must be neatly groomed. Female officers are welcome to donate as well.

Last year F.O.P Lodge #44 was able to raise \$10,000 for the two designated charities.
