



OVI Task Force plans April 25 sobriety checkpoint

The Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate a sobriety checkpoint on Thursday, April, 25, in Dayton. The location of the checkpoint will be announced on April 25.

Dayton Police Department officers, along with officers from the Combined Agency OVI Task Force, will conduct a roadside check of drivers for alcohol and drug impairment. The checkpoint and enhanced patrols are an effort of law enforcement agencies to deter and to apprehend impaired drivers.

New information:

In 2018, there were 559 OVI crashes in Montgomery County: 13 of them were fatal, 227 were injury crashes, and 326 were property damage crashes. In addition, there were 251 drug-related crashes.
