Allegiant adds new nonstop destination from DAY

Dayton International Airport announces an addition to its departure schedule: Allegiant Air will offer a new nonstop flight between Destin-Ft. Walton Beach (VPS) and Dayton (DAY), starting May 14, 2020. This new flight will operate twice weekly seasonally, through the summer months of May to August.

"We are very happy about Allegiant's decision to bring additional service to Dayton. Our travelers will be thrilled to have convenient nonstop access to another amazing Allegiant destination," said Gil Turner, Interim Director of Aviation for the City of Dayton.

Destin-Ft. Walton Beach will be the fourth nonstop destination for Allegiant Air from Dayton International Airport. Allegiant began Florida service from Dayton in April 2016 with flights to Tampa/St. Petersburg and Orlando/Sanford, adding service to Punta Gorda/Ft. Myers in November 2016.
