The Dayton Police Department Safety Building will close on March 6, 2020 at 2:00pm for scheduled maintenance.

For safety purposes during the maintenance, all offices will be closed and will not reopen until 8:00am on Monday, March 9, 2020. Officers will be present but the building will remain closed to the public for the entire weekend.

Regular towed vehicle releases will be handled at Sandy's Towing (1541 South Broadway St.). Owners of a vehicle with a detective hold on it will still need to speak with a detective to get their car back.

Weekend detective or Prosecutor's Office order-ins will happen Sunday morning at 9:00am at the Municipal Courts building at 301 West Third Street.
