



Robin Williams Named Director of Recreation and Youth Services

City Manager Shelley Dickstein has announced the appointment of Robin Williams as Director of the Department of Recreation and Youth Services, effective immediately.

Williams, a 25-year City employee, will oversee the facilities, programs and staff of the Department, which has approximately 120 full-time, part-time and seasonal employees and an annual budget of approximately \$10 million.

Williams has 20 years of experience in Dayton's Recreation and Youth Services operations, serving as administrative manager, business manager and program manager. She has served as Interim Director since October of 2015 and also worked as a tax auditor in the City of Dayton Department of Finance. She earned a B.S. in Business Administration from the University of Tennessee.

"We are happy to see Robin continue to serve the Dayton community in this new capacity," said Dickstein. "Her experience and talent will support the continued enhancement of the programs offered by Recreation and Youth Services."

Recreation and Youth Services operates facilities including four recreation centers, the Dayton Convention Center, three golf centers, two major athletic complexes, four swimming pools, and seven spray parks.

In addition, the Department offers programs including fitness and aquatic programs, athletic leagues, senior programs, summer day camps, and community events including the Downtown Summer Music Series, the Dayton World Soccer Games and the Lights in Flight Fireworks and Festival.
