The City of Dayton Charter Review Committee will meet on Monday, Jan. 4, from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The committee reviews the city charter for potential recommended changes. The meeting will be held remotely and will be available for citizens to watch live at daytonohio.gov/govtv.

This meeting is being held in accordance with changes to both state and local laws regarding public meetings during a state of emergency. In response to COVID-19 and in the interest of public health and welfare, Governor DeWine signed an emergency declaration on March 9, 2020, and the City of Dayton followed with an emergency proclamation on March 12, 2020. On March 25, 2020, the Ohio legislature passed Amended Sub House Bill 197, which in Section 12(B) allows for public meetings and hearings to be conducted by electronic means.
