



Lamonte Hall, Jr., named Assistant to the City Manager

City Manager Shelley Dickstein has announced the appointment of Lamonte Hall, Jr., to the position of Assistant to the City Manager, effective immediately.

Hall's responsibilities will include high-level research and policy work and execution of priority projects. He will also co-lead the City Manager's Diversity-Equity-Inclusion Advisory Committee. The Assistant to the City Manager position is a key component of an efficient and fully functioning City Manager's office.

Hall joined the City of Dayton in 2010 as a recreation facility specialist and was subsequently promoted to recreation program coordinator. In that position, he managed staff, volunteers and resources, as well as major events including the Lights in Flight Fireworks Festival and the Dayton World Soccer Games. Since late 2018, he has served as interim manager of the Dayton Convention Center.



Hall earned a B.A. in Communications at Central State University (2002). He has twice been awarded the City of Dayton's top acknowledgement for employee excellence, the Joseph T. Cline Award.
