



## Elected Dayton Municipal Court Clerk, Mark Owens Retiring

Mark Owens, the Clerk of Dayton Municipal Court, announced today that he would not seek re-election and will retire at the end of this year.

"I have decided that I will not seek re-election to the office of Clerk of Dayton Municipal Court. I was appointed Clerk in January 1991 and have been elected five times since then. At the end of this year I will have served 31 years as Clerk of Court. I am proud of the job my staff and I have done during my years of service. I have strived to make the court more accessible to the community, and I believe we have accomplished that. I will be leaving this office at the end of the year, but intend to be actively involved in my community for many years to come."

Mr. Owens has been Clerk of Court since January 28, 1991. He was elected in 1991, 1997, 2003 and 2015. He was President of the Ohio Association of Municipal Court Clerks in 1997 - 1999, and was named Clerk of Court of the Year, Ohio in 1999.
