



SERVICE Initiative traffic enforcement planned for this weekend

The Dayton Police Department, along with members of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office, and the Trotwood Police Department, will conduct a special traffic safety enforcement operation this upcoming weekend as part of the SERVICE initiative.

The effort will focus on the areas of Salem Avenue, Gettysburg Avenue, Free Pike, and State Rt. 49. Officers will look for violations that could cause crashes, reckless driving, impaired driving, speeding, and unlawful use of ATVs and dirt bikes on roadways.

The operation will occur on Friday, Sept. 3, at 6 p.m., until Saturday, Sept. 4, at 2 a.m. and on Saturday, Sept. 4., from 8 p.m. to midnight.
