



Police asking for assistance in fatal hit and run investigation

Detectives of the Dayton Police Department Traffic Services Unit are actively investigating a recently discovered fatal hit and run.

On Tuesday, Dec. 07, 2021, at 4:36 p.m., Richard Hunt, a 53-year-old male, was found deceased in a tree line in the 4600 block of Free Pike. It was determined that Mr. Hunt was likely struck by a vehicle sometime in October. Detectives believe the vehicle that struck Mr. Hunt fled the scene, and the accident was never reported.

Police are asking for anyone that may have information on this fatal hit and run to please call Detective Rizer at 937-333-1142 or Miami Valley Crime Stoppers at 937-222-STOP. If utilizing Crime Stoppers, callers can remain anonymous and collect a cash reward for information that leads to an arrest.

Any tip or piece of information is significant. Anything pertaining to this investigation will be helpful to detectives in potentially solving the case.
