



Small Business Opportunity Forum - April 21

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The 2022 Small Business Opportunity Forum, presented by the Dayton Human Relations Council, will give local businesses a chance to meet decision makers, learn about and apply for certification at the city, state, and federal levels, and network with prime contractors and community partners. Businesses can also learn about the Dayton Recovery Plan, the City of Dayton's planned use of American Rescue Plan Act funds, and its commitment to Black- and brown-owned businesses.

The free-admission event will take place at the Dayton Metro Library West Branch, 300 Abbey Ave., on Thursday, April 21, from 8:30 a.m. to noon.

The forum will also allow small business owners to learn about construction projects and goods/services acquired by City of Dayton departments and programs including Public Works, Planning/Development, Water, Aviation and Procurement/Purchasing.

In addition, the Business and Technical Assistance Center will share information on the new Passport to Success program, a monthly event assisting underrepresented groups in capacity building.
