---

### What is a JEDD?

---

- A JEDD, or Joint Economic Development District, is an agreement between a township and a city, to promote economic development and fund local governmental services.
- The Miami Township-Dayton JEDD was created in 2005.

### Where is the Miami Township-Dayton JEDD?

---

- The Miami Township-Dayton JEDD is located primarily along Austin Boulevard and Washington Church Road, including the Dayton Wright Brothers Airport.

### What is the proposed change to the JEDD income tax?

---

- The Miami Township-Dayton JEDD is planning an increase to the current income tax.
- The tax rate will increase from 1.75% to 2.25%.
- This change will be effective January 1, 2026.

### What are the additional tax dollars supporting?

---

- Provide funding to support increased demand on services (police, fire, administrative services).
- Infrastructure investment, including funding safety projects on Washington Church Road and Spring Valley Pike.
- Support for essential improvements at the Dayton Wright Brothers Airport.
- Support business retention and growth, as well as attracting new businesses to the area, through economic development grants.
- Consistency across all JEDDs, such as the Miami Crossing and Austin Center JEDDs, that are already at 2.25%.
