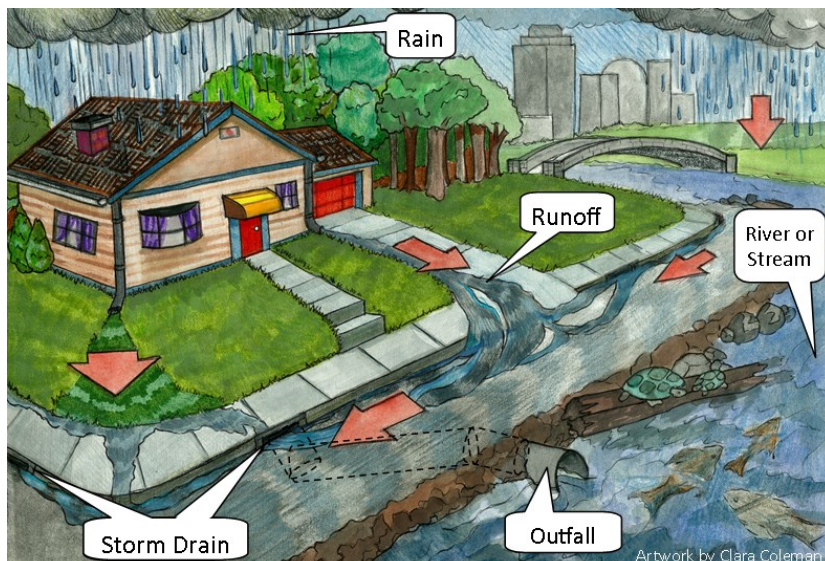
Easy Things Food Vendors Can Do To Stop Pollution of Our Rivers and Streams

- **DO NOT DUMP** waste water or oil of any kind down the storm drains
- Perform regular inspections and repairs to prevent leaks from equipment/storage containers
- Keep the area around you clean by sweeping, picking up trash, and recycling

Storm Drains

- Found in streets and parking lots
- Collect and transport runoff from rainfall
- Drain directly to rivers without any treatment

Sanitary Sewers

- Collect waste water from indoor plumbing (e.g. toilets, sinks, drains, etc)
- Water and waste goes to a wastewater treatment plant
