<b>Do-it-Yourself (DIY) Meeting</b>	Monthly meeting between neighborhood association presidents, planning, and crime prevention officers.	Community Outreach
<b>Downtown Engagement Project</b>	Initiative where police officers identify men and women in downtown Dayton who may be mentally ill or homeless, & inform them where and how to get help.	Community Outreach
<b>Ice Cream Truck</b>	Initiative to provide free ice cream to citizens in order to build relationships	Community Outreach
<b>Impact</b>	Monthly regional discussion between citizens, faith-based leaders & police coordinated with Montgomery County Sheriff's Office.	Community Outreach

<b>NextDoor</b>	A private website designed just for neighbors to keep in touch and share information.	Crime Prevention
<b>Report It (LEADS Online)</b>	Program which lets you securely store serial numbers, item descriptions, pictures, etc.,so these items may be more easily identified in the event of theft or loss.	Crime Prevention
<b>Right of Entry</b>	DPD program whereby property owners/managers give the DPD permission to investigate the activity of anyone on the property.	Crime Prevention

<b>McGruff</b>	McGruff dog costume utilized by police to reach out to children in an effort to increase crime awareness and personal safety.	Juvenile Programs

<b>Snack Back Our Streets</b>	In partnership with the Food Bank an initiative to build positive relationships with youth. Snacks are donated, and police officers distribute them to youth in the neighborhoods in which they work.	Juvenile Programs
<b>Trunk or Treat</b>	Police assist in handing out candy to kids in parking lots where kids go from car to car and get candy. Often held in places where trick-or-treating isn't safe.	Juvenile Programs
<b>Graffiti Clean-Ups</b>	Neighborhood revitalization where graffiti is covered.	Neighborhood Focus
<b>Juvenile Court Clean-Ups</b>	Neighborhood clean-ups done with the assistance of juveniles from the Montgomery County Juvenile Court.	Neighborhood Focus
<b>Mural Painting</b>	Murals throughout the city painted on buildings as part of neighborhood revitalization program.	Neighborhood Focus
<b>Neighborhood Clean-Ups</b>	Neighborhood revitalization where dumped materials are removed, vacant properties are mowed, and shrubbery is trimmed. Montgomery County Jail will provide workers and juvenile court will also help.	Neighborhood Focus
<b>Project Safe Neighborhood (Westwood)</b>	Grant money allocated for the police department and juvenile probation for high-risk juveniles to reduce property/violent crime and recidivism.	Neighborhood Focus
